



Admissions Requirements - RN-BSN Program

Required Pre-requisite Courses:

- BIO 141: Anatomy & Physiology I (4 cr hrs)
- BIO 142: Anatomy & Physiology II (4 cr hrs)
- ENG 111: College Composition I (3 cr hrs)
- PSY Elective Level 200 or Higher (3 cr hrs)
- PSY 230: Developmental Psychology (3 cr hrs)
- HLT 230: Principles of Nutrition and Human Development (3 cr hrs)
- Completion of RN program and active RN license

All pre-requisites must be completed with a grade of “C” or higher, and the pre-req GPA minimum is a 2.0 to be considered for admission. Students who have more than 1 pre-req course in progress at the time of application submission will only be reviewed on a case-by-case basis.

NursingCAS Application:

Your completed online application, High School transcripts, and RN license must be submitted on or before the application deadline. Completed application must be in the *Verified* status on NursingCAS on or before the application deadline.

Each applicant is considered individually using a holistic review. Meeting minimum admissions requirements does not guarantee admission.
