



Nurse Aide Application and Admission Requirements

Application Requirements

Applicants must be 18 years of age prior to the start of the program.

Completed Application: A link to the online application can be found on the Centra College Nurse Aide Program page.

Official High School Transcripts/GED: Final official high school transcript or GED report.

All application requirements must be completed by the published application deadline.

Admission Requirements

Upon acceptance into the program, students must successfully complete a background check and provide documentation of immunizations required by the program. Students must maintain a valid American Heart Association Healthcare Provider CPR card for the duration of the program. CPR training is provided for students the afternoon of orientation.

Students must sign the Centra Nurse Aide Education Program Honor Code.

All students are required to attend an orientation session. Failure to attend could result in Centra College deferring your acceptance or rescinding the admission offer.

The Nurse Aide Education program does not offer credit for experiential learning.
